Group Piano Classes

Young students will learn the skills necessary to play the piano and learn to read music. Children will explore the complexities of music in a creative and nurturing environment. They will learn many skills including: note values, music alphabet, music symbols, music readiness, and steady beat. They will use rhythm instruments and drums while learning to read rhythms and gain musical knowledge that will help build a foundation for their musical pursuit. Each semester will end with a class recital and celebration. Through this fun class setting they will gain self confidence, team work, listening skills and a love for music!

4th-6th grade class will be using "Way cool Keyboarding for kids" curriculum & move at faster pace. In addition to piano instruction and songwriting techniques, they will learn about music history in a fun creative way.

Students will feel an immediate sense of accomplishment. These classes are designed to create "healthy" competition and provide practice motivation. The students will learn how to read music from a staff using guide notes and intervallic reading and also develop their aural skills. They will learn many skills including: music alphabet, music symbols, keyboard geography, critical listening, note reading and team work. Students will gain a knowledge of composers and enjoy their musical pursuit through playing educational and fun theory games.

You will be amazed how quickly these students develop skills and learn to play on their own.
